

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

Class begins when the tardy bell rings and ends when the dismissal bell rings. The entire period is learning time. Students will be in their assigned seats, will have their textbooks opened to the assigned page; and will have blank paper, a pen or pencil, and the homework assignment on their desks before the tardy bell rings. They will pack up for their next class after the dismissal bell.

Ms. J has one classroom rule:

DON'T INTERRUPT LEARNING TIME!

Students will be on time, prepared, on task, and give their best effort.

TASK MANAGEMENT (25% of course grade)

Students begin each class period with five task management points. Points will be subtracted like this:

- 1st Tardy - lose THREE point
- 2nd Tardy - **lose five points**
- 3rd Tardy - **reported to office** (lose 5 pts.)
- Not prepared - **lose five points**
- Disruptive Behavior - (1) warning, (2) **CALL LIST** - lose five pts.

BATHROOM PASSES

Students begin each trimester with six bathroom passes. Use them for emergencies. If you need to use the bathroom, and have no passes left, you may still go, but you will lose five task management points. If you have a related health problem, have your parent contact Ms. J.

MS. J'S CHEATING POLICY

1. If a student is caught cheating on any assignment or test, that assignment or test will be graded NC, and the student will not have the opportunity to redo it.
2. If a student cheats on an Accelerated Reader test, the test will be graded NC.
3. The student will be assigned to four hours detention at Saturday school.
4. Mrs. Wenker will be notified and will apply the district cheating policy.
